The database was managed using T-SQL via a proprietary interface and an XML wrapper. The software interfaced with

both Oracle and MySQL databases and allowed users to manage stored video and other media assets. • Integrated with external vendor hardware using API's that allowed users to transfer digital media from tape and using Windows Media to capture live data feeds to digital files which are transferred to the server and added to the database. • Integrated software with external vendor software controls like video players, grid controls and buttons. • Helped to develop advanced customizable video logging and annotation tools.
