I recently retired from the Army after 21 years of service, where I spent the first half of my career as an Airborne Ranger, culminating in my commanding a company of paratroopers and companies of indigenous militia forces in Shkin, Afghanistan in 2003 and Balad, Iraq in 2004. Since then, I was hand-picked to be a high-level strategic planner in many challenging positions. I was General McChrystal's lead planner in Afghanistan, where I wrote his multi-year campaign plan and campaign design. For the last three years, I was the Military Advisor for Peacekeeping Operations at the Department of State. The State Department awarded me the Superior Honor Award and medal, the equivalent of a Legion of Merit, which is usually reserved only for very senior State Department civilians and rarely awarded to Active Duty military members such as General Petraeus. In fact, Deputy Assistant Secretary (and Rear Admiral) Sam Perez who oversees the GPOI program officiated my retirement ceremony, and Mike Bittrick, the Deputy Director of the Africa Bureau's Regional Security Affairs Office, brought his fiancé to a get-together at my house last week.

With my background and education, you will quickly find that I will be the best program manager that you have ever worked with. Should PMP certification be a requirement, my Senior Associate and I can quickly pass the examination via attending the Boot Camp in Alexandria. Both of us have an active Security Clearance. The VA is still evaluating my disability rating, but I'm certain that by December, I will also be registered as an SDVOSB.
